

Árpád (c. 845 – c. 907), Led the Magyars into Central Europe around 896.



Géza (c. 945 – 997), Grand Prince of the Magyars, baptized by a Benedictine monk, Bruno of the Sankt Gallen Abbey.



Saint Stephen I (967/969/975 –1038), son of Géza, (king 1000-1038)



Andrew I (c. 1015 -1060), (king 1046/1047-1060)



Béla I (c. 1016 – 1063), brother of Andrew I, (king 1060 – 1063)



Solomon (1053–1087), son of Andrew I, (king 1057–1081)



Géza I (c. 1040 –1077), son of Béla I, (king 1074-1077)



Saint Ladislaus I (c. 1040 –1095), son of Béla I, (king1077-1095)



Coloman I (c. 1070 –1116), son of Géza I, (king 1095–1116)

The Hungarian tradition gives precedence to the eldest member of the royal family over the king's son in matters of succession.
